What's the best area and better paid area "Sharepoint Development" (70-542) or "Sharepoint Configuration" (70-630)?

Answer :: If you are a developer, and you love hardware and configuring software, and like to administer, then you should do both.

If you are a Share Point Admin, network admin, database admin, or something like that, you should certify as 70-630.

If you are a developer, you should do 70-542. You should probably look into ASP .NET programming before you get into this one.

You also have to consider that some people think that developing SharePoint is modifying the look and feel on the client side, this is not the case at all, that is called customization, and is something else entirely.
